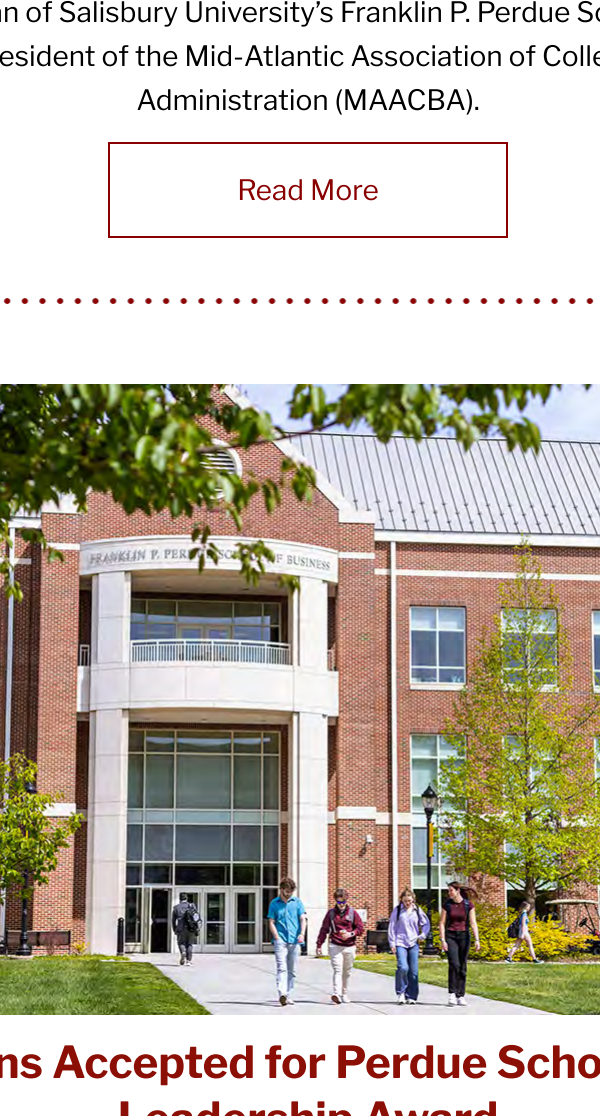
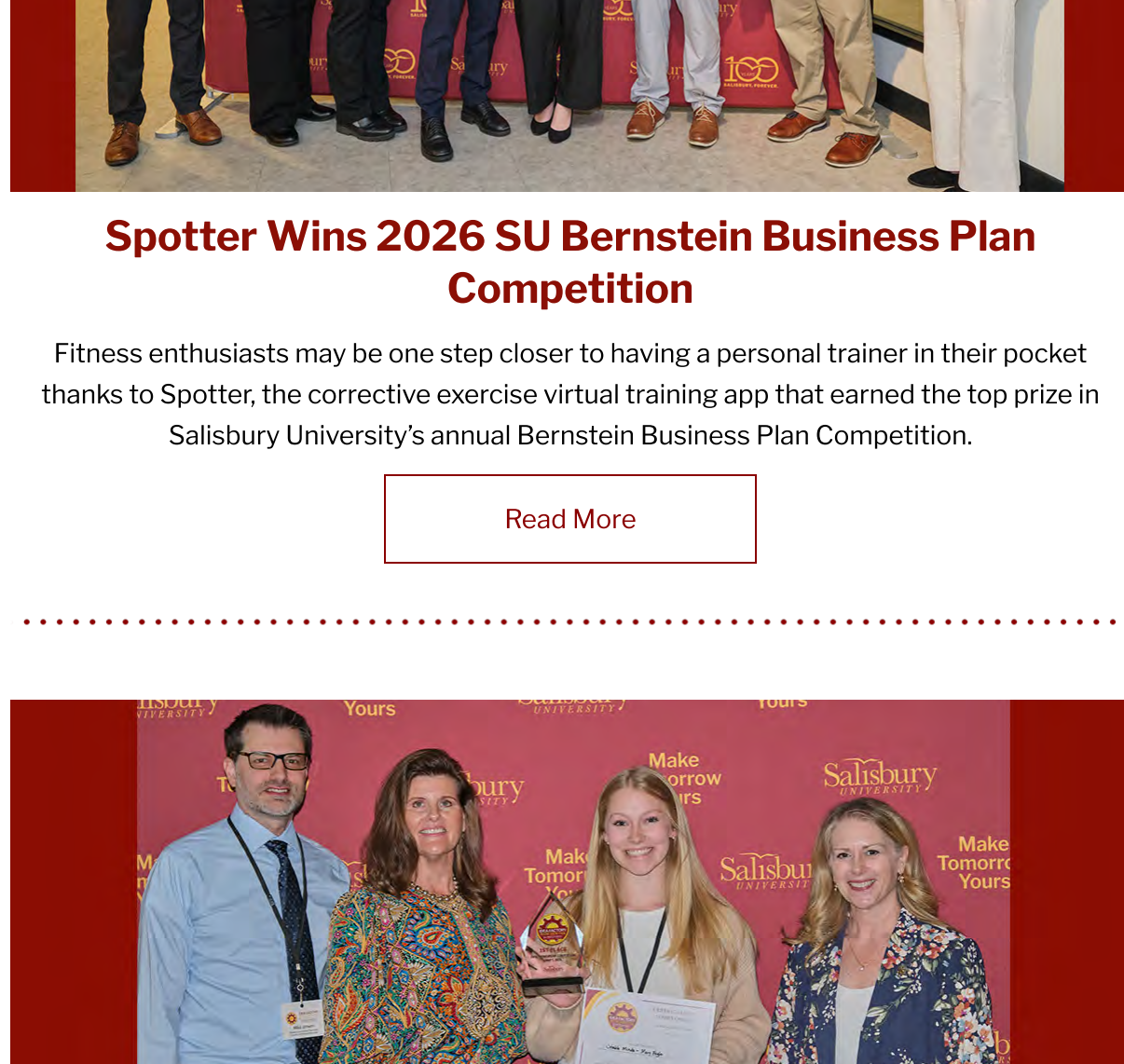




## SU's Weer Named President of the Mid-Atlantic Association of Colleges of Business Administration

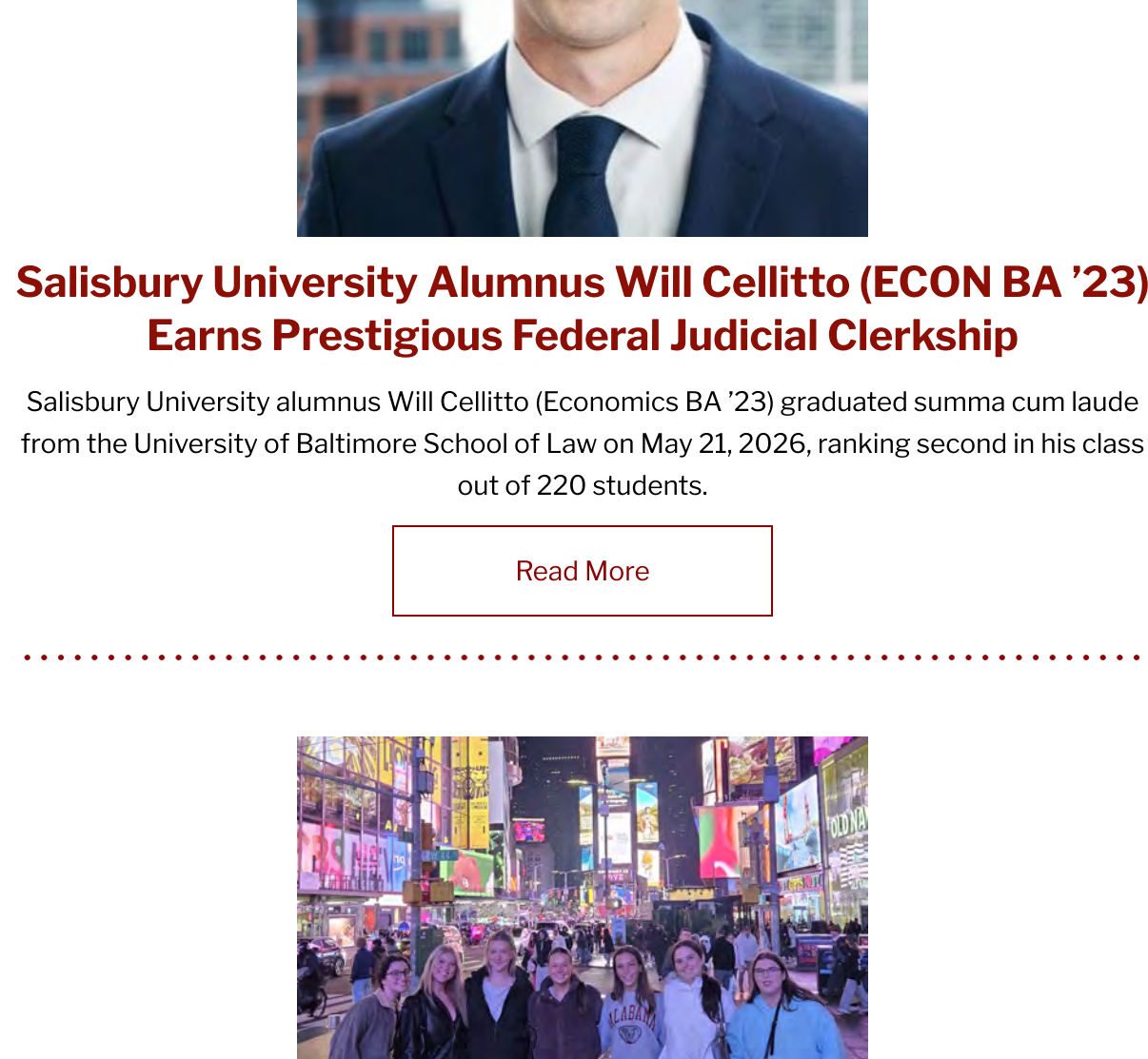
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## Spring MASMI Sales Championship Winners Announced

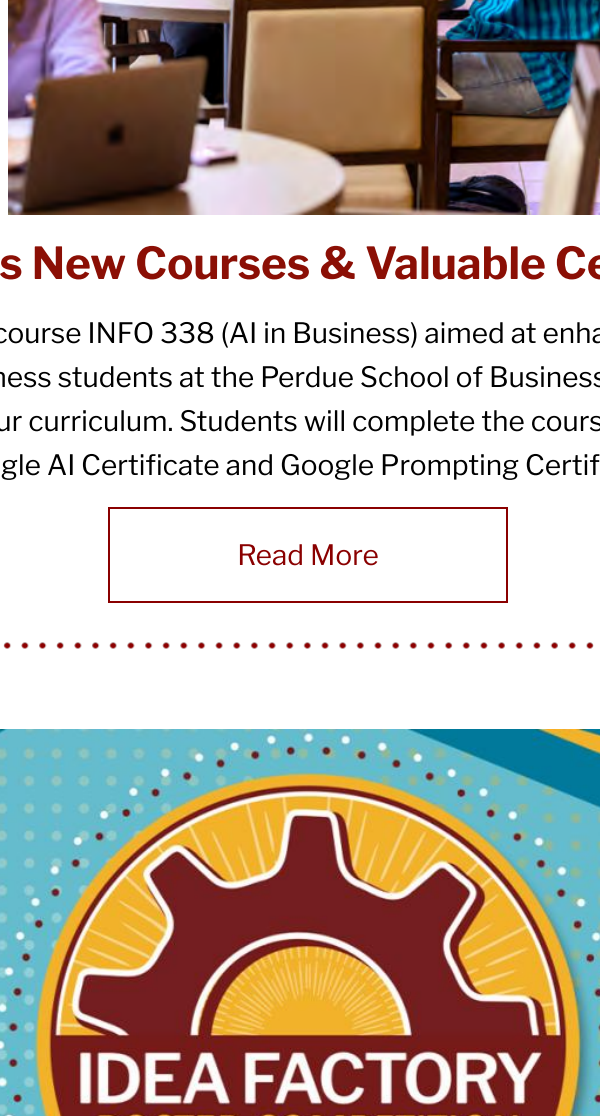

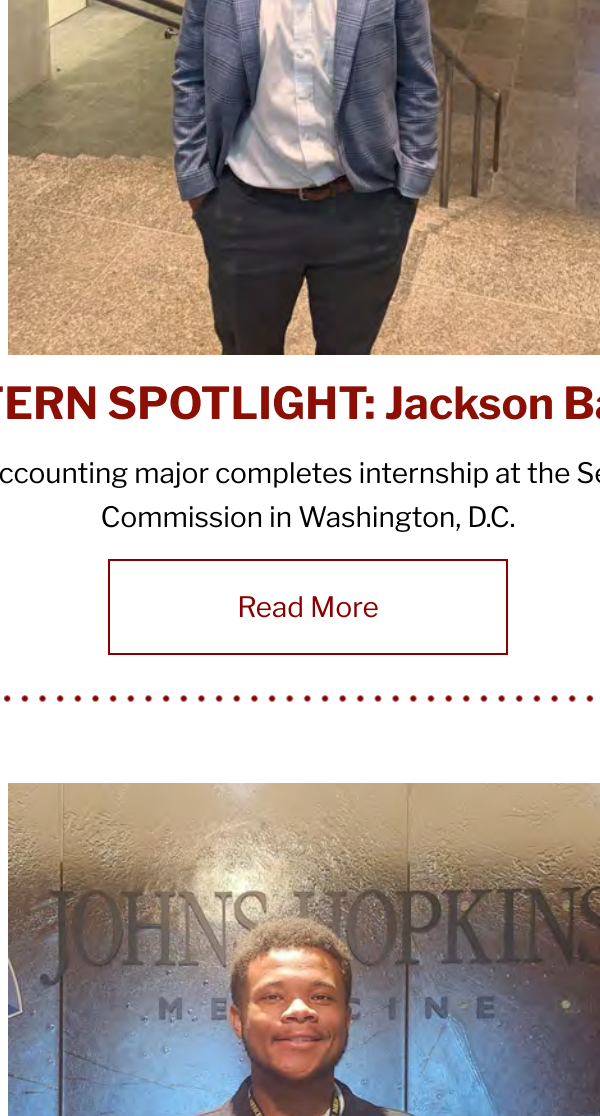
