

The "RACE to Teach" Scholarship, funded by the Maryland Leads Grant, will offer \$5,000 scholarships to high school graduates from Pocomoke, Snow Hill, or Stephen Decatur High Schools. Students eligible to apply include any student who is attending a four-year institution of higher education and majoring in education.

Guidelines for Worcester County Public Schools' graduates who are attending college.

- 1. Applicants are enrolled in a college or university in an education program (elementary/secondary education) for the upcoming academic year.
- 2. Applicant must have a GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 3. Applicants may be asked to participate in a scholarship interview hosted via Zoom with WCPS staff.

The scholarship application packet must be submitted by 4 pm on April 15, 2024. The following documents are required:

- Completed application (pages 1, 2, 3)
- An unofficial current transcript
- A resume
- Two letters of recommendation
- 4. The scholarship committee shall select a recipient within the following criteria:
