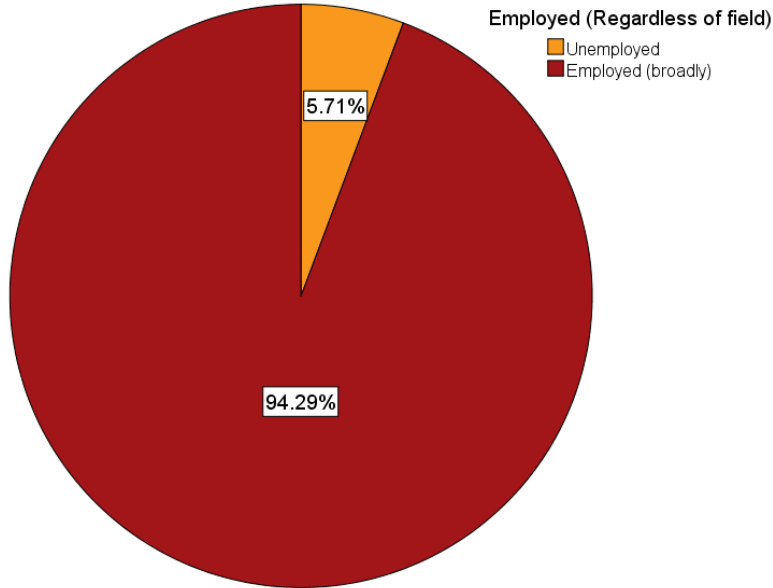




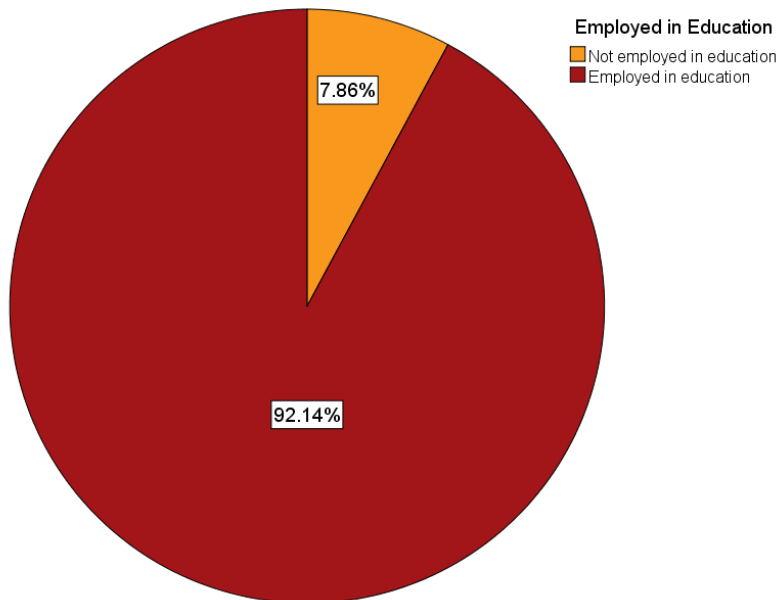
### Employment Outcomes for Completers (2015-2017 and 2016-2017)
