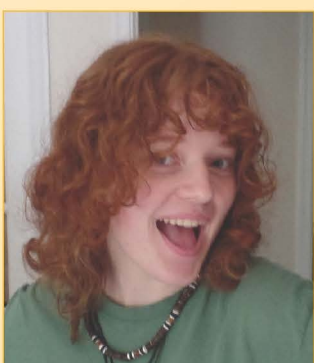
### Samuel Gundlach
