
Secrets of Salisbury Walking Tours

SU Campus Walkabout Map Download and Instructions

- Download and install Google Maps on your smartphone.
- Open sharable SU campus walkabout placemarks map by clicking on one of these web addresses or using the QR code.

- The Google Maps app should open and zoom to the placemarks (Red Icons) and route for the SU Campus Walkabout.
 - Note: Changing the base layer to imagery makes the icons and route more visible.
- You can follow the blue route to the suggested locations which are symbolized in Red and sequentially numbered.
- Or you can click on a Red icon, and select Directions to see additional possible routes and the estimated time to arrival.
 - Note: Be sure to select Walking directions on screen top.
 - o Also Note: Google will only give you a route on what it believes is a sidewalk!
 - Also, Also Note: GPS doesn't work properly inside a building!
- You can also click on the next Red icon and select Add Stop on screen bottom to construct a sequence of stops (or route). You can add as many stops as you like or simply navigate between each location.
- Click Start to receive verbal directions from Google Maps.
- Several placemarks have additional information available if you click the Red icon.
- If the Purple icons and route disappear, reload the Walkabout map from the shared web address or QR code.

 - Note: Changing the base layer to imagery makes the icons and route more visible.
- You can follow the suggested blue route to the suggested locations which are symbolized in Purple and sequentially numbered.
- Or you can click on a Purple icon, and select Directions to see additional possible routes and the estimated time to arrival.
 - o **Note**: Be sure to select Walking directions on screen top.
 - Also Note: Google will only give you a route on what it believes is a sidewalk!
 - Also, Also Note: GPS doesn't work properly inside a building!
- You can also click on the next Purple icon and select Add Stop on screen bottom to construct a sequence of stops (or route). You can add as many stops as you like or simply navigate between each one.
- Click Start to receive verbal directions from Google Maps.
- Several placemarks have additional information available if you click the Purple icon.
- Note that the SU Gallery Building has restrooms and water available.
- If the Purple icons and route disappear, reload the Downtown Walkabout from the shared web address or QR code.
