### Book

Last name, First and Middle initials of author. (Publication Year). *Title of book: Capital letter also for subtitle*. Publisher Name. DOI (if available)

Example: Isaacs, W. (1999). *Dialogue and the art of thinking together*. Doubleday.

### Work in an Anthology or Collection

Last name, First and Middle initials of author. (Publication Year). Title of chapter. In Editors' Names (Eds.), *Title of book* (page range). Publisher. DOI (if available)

Example: North, S.M. (1995). The idea of a writing center. In C. Murphy & J. Law (Eds.), *Landmark essays on writing centers* (pp. 71-85). Hermagoras Press.

### Journal Article

Author Last name, First and Middle initials of author. (Publication Year). Title of article: Capital for subtitle. *Title of Journal, Volume*(Issue Numbers), Page Range. DOI

Example: Corbett, S. J. (2013). Negotiating pedagogical authority: The rhetoric of writing center tutoring styles and methods. *Rhetoric Review*, 32(1), 81-98. doi:10.1080/07350198.2013.739497

### Website

Last name, First and Middle initials of author. (Publication Date). *Title of the page*. Site name. URL

Example: Horrigan, J.B. (2016, September 9). *Libraries 2016*. Pew Research Center.

*Title of page*. (Publication Date). Site name. URL

Example: *Martin Luther King, Jr.* (2009). History.com. <https://www.history.com/topics/black-history/martin-luther-king-jr>

### In-text Citations

**Paraphrasing:** According to Last Name (Year), paraphrased material... **OR** Paraphrased material....(Last Name, Year).

**Quoting:** According to Last Name (Year), "quoted material" (p. #). **OR** "Quoted material" (Last Name, Year, p. #).

**Two Authors:** Research by Last Name and Last Name (Year) shows... **OR** (Last Name & Last Name, Year)

**Three or More Authors:** Research by Last Name et al. (Year) shows... **OR** (Last Name et al., Year)
