

FS Officers' Proposed Method for the Revision of the Faculty Handbook

Background

On May 10, 2022, the Faculty Senate passed a motion approving the revised Faculty Handbook with directions that three sections be revised “via a method to be determined by the Faculty Senate Officers and approved by the Faculty Senate.” Two sections, “Technology Fluency” and “Technology-Mediated Instructional Material”, were to be revised within a year. The third section, “Faculty Workload and Responsibilities”, was to be revised within two years.

Plan

“Technology Fluency”: The Academic Policies Committee (APC) shall be charged to review and revise this section, with proposed revisions to be brought to the Faculty Senate no later than the March 28, 2023 meeting.

“Technology-Mediated Instructional Material”: The Library and Learning Resources Committee (LLRC) shall be charged to review and revise this section, with proposed revisions to be brought to the Faculty Senate no later than the March 28, 2023 meeting.

“Faculty Workload and Responsibilities”: The Faculty Welfare Committee (FWC) shall be charged to review and revise this section, with proposed revisions to be brought to the Faculty Senate no later than the final meeting in Fall 2023.
