

## Provost's Announcements to the Faculty Senate September 27, 2022

- 1. Faculty Development Website to Launch by early October:** Jessica Clark (Assistant Provost for Faculty Success), Instructional Design & Delivery staff, and several others are nearing completion on a faculty development website that will launch by early October. - 2. Full-time Non-Tenure Track Faculty Titles and Ranks:** I have been asked to serve on a USM workgroup regarding titles for non-tenure track faculty whose responsibilities are largely focused on teaching. Currently, only the titles of Lecturer and Senior Lecturer are available for non-clinically teaching-focused faculty. I will keep the Faculty Senate apprised of these discussions which are intended to recognize the contributions of and build a career ladder for non-tenure track faculty. **FS Action Requested: Happy to take any questions or feedback.**
- 3. Transfer Portal:** The Registrar's Office has implemented a [Transfer Portal](#) that allows prospective and incoming transfer students to determine if and how their courses would transfer to Salisbury University. Students can even upload a copy of their transcript for review. This platform incorporates all existing SU course equivalencies and should facilitate greater ease of transfer and course evaluation. **FS Action Requested: Happy to take any questions or feedback.**
- 4. Key Data Visualizations:** In an effort to make key indicators available to faculty, department chairs, school directors, and others, SU's ESRGC has developed two dashboards: 1) [Degrees awarded by school/college/program and semesters to degree](#); and 2) [Credit Hours by school/college/program and term](#). A dashboard for key enrollment indicators is in development. We'll be sharing this out in the First Monday email for October. **FS Action Requested: Happy to take any questions or feedback.**
- 5. Building Access:** We continue to work on access issues for campus visitors and are now incorporating parking as part of their access so regular campus visitors do not need to request a visitor parking pass each time they come to campus. **FS Action Requested: Happy to take any questions or feedback.**
