What is Be a Santa to a Senior?

At Home Instead, program organizers connect with senior centers, nursing homes, adult medical daycares, and health departments to get lists of names of seniors who are lonely, financially challenged, or unlikely to receive a gift during the winter season.

Participants are asked to purchase the gift, wrap it, and return it to the site where they picked up the ornament with their senior's information.
