VOICES AND VOTES

You've probably seen the Smithsonian traveling exhibit, "Voices and Votes: Democracy in America," on the first floor of the Academic Commons. It is eve-catching (and a little noisier than we'd like, truth be told, since we don't want to distract people who are studying). But did you know there's more? Up on the 4th floor, in the Thompson Gallery, you will find our local version of the exhibit, created by our staff. It's called (cleverly!), "Voices and Votes: Democracy on Delmarva," and features local stories of rebellion, resistance, and perseverance. The 1st floor exhibit will be available until mid-October and is open when the GAC is open. The 4th floor exhibit will be available all semester and is open M-F 10 am-4 pm.

Mobile Self-Checkout

The SU Libraries have a new app for mobile self-checkout. It's called Meescan and allows you to check out most books at the SU Libraries right on your iOS or Android device. You can download the app in your phone's store or from our website. After you check out a book, be sure to de-sensitize it at one of the Meescan stations around the library (they are found in the Pit on the 1st floor, outside the elevators on the 3rd floor, and in the south-side reading room on the 3rd floor).
